### Background:

Established by: St Charles Singers in 2005

Length of Scholarship: 1 year, non-renewable

Purpose: To encourage any student who is planning to participate in choir throughout his or her college experience and who has a strong desire to further his or her choral experience.

Applicants need not be majoring in music to qualify.

### Applicant:

Seniors currently attending: Batavia, Geneva, Kaneland, Wheaton North or Wheaton Warrenville South

Student has applied to any accredited public or private college, university or conservatory

Specialized Study: Not required

Special Characteristics:

1. Member of high school vocal music program for at least 3 years
2. Exhibit qualities of scholarship, leadership, hard work and responsibility in pursuing/developing musicianship

Financial Need: N/A

Minimum GPA: 2.0

Written Essay: Yes (see application)

References: 3 (can be a vocal teacher, other educator, counselor, pastor, etc. Not a relative!)

Finalist Interview: at the discretion of the Program Committee depending on applications received.

### Award:

Amount of Award: Two \$1000 scholarships will be awarded.

Award Recognition: All scholarships will be awarded at a St Charles Singers concert Saturday, May 19, 7:30 PM at Baker Memorial United Methodist Church, St. Charles or Sunday May 20, 7 PM at Fourth Presbyterian Church, Chicago. Recipients and their families will be guests at the concert. *The winner is expected to attend the concert to receive their award.*
